



## DISCOUNTS WITH HOP-ON HOP-OFF TICKET

- 1 **JT-Line Ferry to Suomenlinna:** Adults 5,50€ (norm. 7€), children 7-16 yrs 2,50€
- 2 **Flytour XD Helsinki:** Entrance 9,50€ (norm. 11,50€)
- Skywheel Helsinki:** Adults -2€, children (3-11 yrs) -1,50€ discount from normal entrance.
- 3 **Café Regatta:** 2 regular cups of coffee for the price of 1.
- 4 **Sea Life Helsinki:** -25% discount from normal entrance.
- 5 **National Museum of Finland:** Adult entrance 7€ (norm. 10€), children under 18 yrs free.
- 6 **Hard Rock Cafe:** Free gift when you spend 35€ or more in Hard Rock Cafe Rock Shop
- 7 **Design Museum Helsinki:** Adult entrance 7€ (norm. 10€).

- 1 **Senate Square** The Cathedral - an Iconic Landmark. Built during the Russian rule as a tribute to Czar Nicholas I. Open from 9:00, times vary. Free Entrance. Take a break in one of the many cozy cafés in the area and shop for Finnish Handicrafts and Souvenirs.
- 2 **Havis Amanda** Famous statue sculpted in 1906. Visit the Old Market Hall and SkyWheel Helsinki and experience the ultimate Sightseeing ride at Flytour XD. Take JT-Line Ferry to Suomenlinna. Shop for unique Jewelry and Design.
- 3 **Olympia Terminal/Mannerheim Museum** Ferries to Stockholm - terminal built for the 1952 Olympics. Museum dedicated to Gustaf Mannerheim, Marshal of Finland.
- 4 **Kaivopuisto Park** Take a walk in beautiful Kaivopuisto Park - Popular picnic spot for locals. Take a stroll up to the Observatory hill and enjoy the spectacular sea view.
- 5 **Compass Square** Stroll along the beautiful waterfront of Eira and enjoy a refreshing ice cream by the seaside.
- 6 **Eira** Beautiful neighborhood with jugend style houses and embassies. Visit popular and elegant Café Carousel.
- 7 **Hernesaari Cruise Terminal** A docking point for international cruise ships. Operated in connection with specific cruise ships.
- 8 **Hernesaari Bay** offers Cafés, Restaurants, Terraces, and traditional Finnish Sauna The Löyly with unique architecture.
- 9 **Melkki Cruise Terminal** Another docking point for international cruise ships. Operated in connection with specific cruise ships.
- 10 **Hietalahti Flea Market/Market Hall** Charming flea market at the Hietalahti Market Square and traditional covered food market.

- 11 **Bulevardi** The Boulevard is known for cafés and art galleries. Visit Fredrikinkatu district for unique and exclusive shopping.
- 12 **Kamppi** Tennispalatsi (Tennis Palace) Art Museum, Kamppi Shopping Centre, Natural History Museum.
- 13 **Rock Church** Discover the most unique church in Finland, built into the Bedrock. Explore the impressive interior. Open from 10:00, times vary. Entrance fee 3€.
- 14 **Sibelius Monument** An impressive stainless steel monument dedicated to the world famous composer Jean Sibelius. Free entrance. Enjoy a cup of coffee and traditional cinnamon Bun in the countryside style Café Regatta by the seaside.
- 15 **Olympic Stadium** Take a picture of the Olympic Stadium. The Stadium is closed for renovations. Visit the Helsinki Tram Museum at the Tram Depot.
- 16 **SeaLife/Linnanmäki** Visit Sea Life Helsinki and Linnanmäki Amusement Park. Take a stroll along the shores of Töölö Bay. Visit Helsinki City Botanic Garden.
- 17 **Parliament/National Museum** The Parliament of Finland. Explore the history of Finland at the National Museum. Visit the Helsinki Music Centre.
- 18 **City Centre/Lasipalatsi** A good spot for shopping - Sokos Department Store and Forum Shopping Centre. Visit Hard Rock Cafe Helsinki.
- 19 **Swedish Theatre** Visit Stockmann Department Store and shop for Finnish Design in the Esplanade shopping street. Short walking distance to Design Museum Helsinki.
- 20 **Esplanade Park/Market Square** Stroll along historical Esplanade and take the Original Helsinki Sightseeing Cruise from Market Square to see the beautiful archipelago (1½ h).
